# PREACHER SCHOOL Pneumatology — Class Syllabus

**Introduction:** The Holy Spirit is God. He is the Third, Co-Equal Person of the Trinity. The Trinity is One. They are Three Persons who are together, One God. Three Persons sharing the same essential essence. The Three Persons are Father, Son, and Holy Spirit and while they share in a profound Oneness they have different functions or operations, yet they are together, One God. The Trinity exists without hierarchy, One loves the Others, serves the Others, yields to the Others, is humble before the Others, maintains, protects, and works for the good of the Others, in perfect Love and unity.

That introduction is a summary of Trinitarian theology. We have a monotheistic, Trinitarian faith. This is a difficult subject for the bravest and most adept theologians so relax and maybe re-read introductory paragraph again to simply consider how complex and mysterious our Great God is! And remember, while He is so beyond our comprehension, He also seeks to make Himself intimately known to us.

**THE MISSION OF JESUS** was fourfold: 1) Demonstrate what God is like; 2) Demonstrate the perfect human life, empowered for loving-service to God through the Holy Spirit; 3) Completely destroy the power of sin and death; and 4) Establish the New Covenant which is the pouring out of the Holy Spirit upon all flesh, so we become his prophetic people who live by revelation, empowered for life.

Jesus was temporarily our Emmanuel, "Behold, the virgin will conceive and give birth to a Son, and they shall name Him Immanuel, which translated means, 'God with us.'" (Matt 1:28, NASB. Both "E" or "I" for Emmanuel is correct). After His resurrection, and right before He ascended to heaven Jesus said, "Behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age" (Matt 28:20). This could have been confusing to His disciples because He no longer said that and they watched Him ascend into the clouds (Acts 1:9).

God's intention was the permanent giving of the Holy Spirit. Jesus had explained this at the Last Supper, "I tell you the truth: it is to your advantage that I am leaving; for if I do not leave, the Helper will not come to you; but if I go, I will send Him to you... [And] when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will guide you into all the truth; for He will not speak on His own, but whatever He hears, He will speak; and He will disclose to you what is to come. He will glorify Me, for He will take from Me and will disclose it to you. All things that the Father has are Mine; this is why I said that He takes from Me and will disclose it to you" (John 16:7-13-15). Jesus opened the way for the Holy Spirit to be our permanent Emmanuel, the Holy Spirit is God with us, now.

The Holy Spirit, the One with us now, is the most neglected member of the Trinity. The Holy Spirit is the most misunderstood, most blasphemed, and most rejected of the Three. And I am

pretty sure this is why Jesus warned, "Therefore I say to you, every sin and blasphemy shall be forgiven people, but blasphemy against the Spirit shall not be forgiven. And whoever speaks a word against the Son of Man, it shall be forgiven him; but whoever speaks against the Holy Spirit, it shall not be forgiven him, either in this age or in the age to come" (Matt 21:31-32).

### **Course Objectives:**

- 1. To be able to answer, Who Is the Holy Spirit?
- 2. To know and live empowered by the Holy Spirit.
- 3. To understand and flow in the many, varied gifts He brings in to our lives.
- 4. To be able to communicate what the Baptism of the Holy is, what the gifts are, and activate them in others.

Benefits/purpose behind the written assignments: the practice of writing forces us to think more carefully about the words we use and the subject we are writing about. This has a two-

### **Weekly Assignments:**

### WEEK 1 – The "Spirit of God"

**Tier one and two:** Search the Scriptures for the biblical emphasis of the "spirit." The NASB translation records "spirit" 599 times but translations vary. Where "spirit" is not capitalized in the bible it will refer to the human spirit or a demon spirit. When it is capitalized, it refers to the Holy Spirit. The noun form always designates His name. Below you will find a couple links to various translations as well as Hebrew and Greek links to the original languages. Note: *ruach* for Hebrew, *Pneuma* for Greek is translated into English as "spirit."

\*The Spurgeon videos are narrated sermons. Spurgeon ministered in the second half of the 1800s during the Second Great Awakening in America. There had been other smaller, sporadic and local revivals, but the First and Second Great Awakenings were widespread and phenomenal in comparison. Spurgeon stands as a champion of the Holy Spirit so much that even today he is lovingly called the Prince of Preachers.

**Assignment tier one:** pick a translation and read around some of the verses. Read beyond the initial verse to get its context. Pick five verses from the Old Testament and five from the New Testament that are specifically about the Holy Spirit and write about what you found interesting from the verses. (300 -500 max response paper)

**Assignment tier two:** poke around the various translations and see if you can find what other words are used instead of "spirit." Can you suggest reasons why these other words may have been used? This kind of question is where deeper curiosity begins the process of deeper study into the word of God. It can be times consuming but it is worth the time spent, it is the Word of God!! 300-500 (max) response paper.
