Dress Code

We are not enforcing a *strict* dress code as we believe parents and students are responsible and do discern appropriateness for class situations. However, we are asking for respect in this area for the sake of the biblical values they represent and for the peace and order of the learning environment. We encourage dignity, self-awareness, and practical modesty. In our academy, clothing will not establish social status and will not be a means of gaining inappropriate attention. We ask the families who share the biblical values of this academy to uphold this code.

Our code:

1. No pajamas.
2. No underwear is to be showing.
3. No bare midriffs, exposed backs, or low plummeting tops.
4. Tights can be worn with a long shirt, dress, or jacket that covers the buttock area.
5. Shorts, skorts, skirts, and dresses should be no shorter than mid-thigh.
6. Shoes are to be worn.
7. Certain science labs will require protective clothing.

We will ask students to appropriately cover up if there is an issue. The dress code is for in-person classes and offsite sponsored fieldtrips.

Please note: some classes may require specific attire, protective clothing, and hair considerations. For example, hair should be safely secured during certain science experiments. Specific requirements will be outlined in the syllabus and in class.

Violation/Enforcement: Students will be asked to respect the code out of respect for other students and teachers. We understand forgetfulness, accidents, and missed laundry days occur, *we are teaching teenagers*. However, if violations persist in a rebellious manner, we will ask to meet with the parent(s) and student to discuss.
