The information here is provided for parents to understand what their student needs for graduation. Math -3 credits required:

Algebra 1 – required

English -4 credits required, elective:

Literature: General Lit., or American Lit., World, Ancient, Biblical, etc.

*Classes here are flexible/elective.

Science -3 credits required:

9th grade – Biology – required

10th grade – Chemistry – required

11th grade - Physics, Marine Biology, Human Anatomy, or similar elective.

*These do not need to be taken in the grade year, completion is what matters.
